**Screening for students with a reading age below 7**

All students in Year 7 and 8 (set 4 and 5 in Year 9) have AR once a week/once a fortnight.

All students in Year 7, 8 and 9 have a Reciprocal Reader lesson in English. This will also be used as a whole-school strategy.

All students with a reading age **below their calendared age** will receive small group intervention with an English teacher, TA or a trained sixth-form reading ambassador.

All students with a reading age **below their calendared age** will receive this one-to-one intervention with an English teacher

All students with a reading age between **6.6 and 9.6** will receive small group intervention with an English teacher, TA or a trained sixth-form reading ambassador using the programme Rapid Plus.

This will be for students whose reading age and phonics assessment shows they still have a challenge around decoding.
