Year 7 Review Meeting – Friday 19th January 2024

I would like to invite you to attend your child's year 7 review meeting. The review meeting is an opportunity for parents to come into the academy to meet with their child's tutor to discuss the progress made during the first term at Redhill and to discuss targets for the year ahead.

When will the review meetings take place?

School will finish at the end of period 4 (2.05pm) for **all** year groups on Friday 19th January 2024 so that tutors can meet with the parents of the year 7s in their tutor group. The meetings usually last around fifteen minutes. Appointments can be made between 2.05 pm and 4.05 pm.

How to book a review meeting with your child's tutor

Your child will be responsible for making the appointment with their tutor. The appointment time will then be recorded in their planner. If you have a preferred time, please write this in your child's planner.

Where will the meeting take place?

Meetings usually take place in your child's tutor room. We suggest that you arrange to meet with your child before the start of your meeting so they can show you to the correct room.

Not available on Friday 19th January 2024?

If you are unable to attend the review meeting on this day, please let us know the times you are available during the week by writing a note in your child's planner. Their tutor will then be in touch to arrange a time for you to come in. We would encourage all parents to come into the academy for their meeting, however, if you are not able to attend in person, please inform your child's tutor via the planner of a suitable time they can call you instead.

Please note: There will be an opportunity for parents to speak to their child's individual subject teachers during parents evening later in the academic year (18th April 2024). More details will be shared nearer the time.
