Year 9 Options Process

As we approach the second half of the academic year, most of our year 9 students have a clear idea of the subjects they would like to study in the future. We recognise this and in preparation for next year, we would like to give our year 9 students the opportunity to shape their curriculum via our options process.

In year 10 (2024-25), all students will be required to study English, Maths, Science, Core Religious Studies, Core PE (Physical Education) * and PSHE (Personal, Social, Health, and Economic) *. They must then choose 4 subjects from the list below:

*non-examined

French (GCSE) Art (GCSE) Business (GCSE) Geography (GCSE) Computer Science (GCSE) German (GCSE) Dance (GCSE) Design and Technology (GCSE) History (GCSE) Textiles (GCSE) Music (GCSE) Drama (GCSE) Food Preparation and Nutrition (GCSE)

Health and Social Care (BTEC) Philosophy, Religion and Ethics (GCSE) Physical Education (GCSE)

To support students throughout the options process we will direct each student to a specific pathway based on their academic attainment so far. Each student will shortly receive a personalised options form that will recommend one of the following pathways:

Pathway 1 – Students on this pathway will be required to study the English Baccalaureate (EBacc). They must therefore select a humanities subject (History or Geography) and a modern foreign language (French or German). They will then make two additional choices from the list above.

Pathway 2 - Students must select one of the following: History, Geography, German, French or Computer Science, plus three additional courses from the list above.

Pathway 3 – Students will study a foundation learning course, plus three subjects from the list above.

Throughout the options process students will be encouraged to make logical and ambitious choices. To help with this, we will be providing you and your child with the following information and support over the coming weeks.
