If you are unable to collect your results on Thursday 14th August, then you will need to provide a personal email address for your results to be sent to. You will need to let Mrs Elliot know if this is the case: exam.officer@theredhillacademy.org.uk . (If you would prefer for your results to be posted home, then please provide a stamped addressed envelope to Mrs Elliot before the end of term).

This will be the culmination of a lot of hard work during what has been a very challenging two years for us all. We hope that these results fairly reflect the effort that you have put in during your time at school and enable you to progress successfully to your chosen destination. Members of our team will be present during the day for anyone who needs support with next steps, UCAS Clearing etc.

- You could email prior to results day to enquire about admission and places available
