Sixth Form Facilities

Post-16 students at Redhill are based in a separate building specially designed for Post-16 study, with dedicated airy, modern teaching spaces and technology to support teaching and learning.

The Post-16 centre includes the refurbished and expanded Study Centre, equipped with a suite of desktop computers, Chromebooks, printing facilities, independent work stations and group work tables. The centre hosts a library of Post-16 literature, including career journals, research opportunities and higher education information. Students also have access to the excellent facilities in the main school buildings, including Dance and Drama studios, sound-proof Music rooms, a new suite of Macbook computers, newly refurbished Science laboratories and specialist ICT suites.

In addition, our new Oakwood Campus has state-of-the-art facilities for those students studying BTEC courses and T Levels with us.

The Post-16 provision fosters a culture of independence, learning and success, and provides a wide range of opportunities for students to flourish as individuals. Every student will be supported and encouraged to aim high, enjoy new experiences and achieve their full

potential. Our student support system is led by an experienced team and an Academic Mentor, who work with a dedicated team of Sixth Form Tutors. The Sixth Form Team provides support and guidance to students throughout and beyond their A level study, as well as delivering a full PSHE programme geared towards managing the transitions taking place for students.

We aim to help all students adjust to the new working methods of Post-16 study in a caring environment underpinned by a culture of hard work and commitment. Our full time Academic Mentor provides one to one support to help students improve their study skills. We develop strong partnerships with all of our students, ensuring that we give regular careers guidance, financial advice and specific UCAS application support.

At Redhill Academy Sixth Form we pride ourselves on students, teachers, tutors and parents working together to achieve excellence.

A Levels

All students must attain five 9 - 4 grades at GCSE, including a grade 4 in English Language and Mathematics. Individual subjects may require specific grades in a particular subject at GCSE.

All students are expected to choose 3 A-Levels, which they will study for 2 years. There is also an option for students gaining a grade 7 in Mathematics to study Further Maths. In addition, students will choose to study an enrichment course which they will follow in Year 12.

Level 3 BTEC courses

All students must attain five 9-4 grades at GCSE, all students without a grade 4 in English Language or Mathematics will be required to follow a course which will enable them to achieve this whilst in sixth form. Each Level 3 course has the following specific requirements that must be achieved alongside their five 9-4 grades:

Sport requires grade 3 or higher in English Language and Mathematics

Health and Social Care requires a grade 3 or higher in English language and Mathematics

Early Years and Education requires grade 4 in English Language or Mathematics

Oakwood Campus

Redhill Sixth Form offers a T-Level in Early Years and Education and BTEC extended diplomas in Sport and Health and Social Care. These courses offer a more practical pathway to students with the same potential to continue to higher level apprenticeships and university. BTEC qualifications are assessed by coursework and practical assessments as well as examination. T-Levels are assessed by exams, project work and assessed work experience placements in nursery or infant schools two days a week. This pathway also offers students the opportunity to gain valuable work experience as part of the course.
