



Dear Year 13 student

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements regarding the collection of A-level results. As you may be aware, examination results are being released earlier this Summer and will be available to collect from school on Tuesday 10 August 2021. In order to be able to do this in a safe and organised way there will need to be a clear system as to how this will be run. Students will be allocated a time slot to arrive. Your time is indicated below:

[You will have received your time slot on a letter sent via the post. If you do not know your time slot, please be in touch with the Sixth Form Office]

On the day, report to the sixth form centre as close to the allocated time as possible in order to enable us to stagger the number of students effectively and ensure the safety of everyone on site. Hands will need to be sanitised on entering the building and there will be a one-way system to ensure that you can both collect your results and seek any support that you may need on the day. If you would prefer to not come into school then your results could be emailed home to you given that you have provided an email address to be able to share those with you. If this is something you would like to do then please email exam.officer@theredhillacademy.org.uk. At the end of the day, any results which have not been collected by Y13 students will be posted home.

This will be the culmination of a lot of hard work during what has been a very challenging year for us all. We hope that these results fairly reflect the effort that you have put in during your time at school and enable you to progress successfully to your chosen destination. Members of our team will be present during the day for anyone who needs support with next steps, UCAS Clearing etc.

I would like to remind you at this point that the appeal of a grade can result in the grade going down as well as up.
